AND WHEREAS the indemnifier has represented to the Government that the said cheque has been lost by him/during transmission by post to him.

AND WHEREAS at the request the indemnifier the Government has agreed to issue a second cheque for Rs being the amount of the said previous cheque no..... datedupon the indemnifier giving such indemnity as hereinafter contained.

NOW IT SI HEREBY AGREED by and between the parties thereto as follows:

The indemnity bond is to be executed by the party requesting for issue of fresh cheque on stamp paper.

The value of stamp duty will depend on the amount for which indemnification is required and could be ascertained from DGC (Civil) as the tariff may diff may state to state.
